CULTURAL IMPACT

MEDIAPHILOSOPHY

Since 1980, Saarinen has constantly appeared in Finnish media in tv, radio, magazines, newspapers, social media and youtube, serious and less serious, becoming a household name. Breaking new ground with the concept and practice of media philosophy and with popular lectures, Saarinen has brought philosophy far beyond the academic classroom and has helped to establish philosophy as an exciting and engaging discipline.

Saarinen has been a key force in the rise of the perception of the contemporary relevance and popularity of philosophy in Finland.

In a ballot of Helsingin Sanomat, Finland's leading newspaper, Saarinen was ranked in 1989 as the 4th most prominent intellectual of the country, ranking as the only intellectual of his generation in the top 20. In a ballot of Suuret suomalaiset (The Greatest Finns) arranged by the Finnish Broadcasting Company TV-1 in 2004, Saarinen was ranked no 92.

PHILOSOPHY AT THE WORKPLACE

In addition to changing the image of philosophy in Finnish media and in popular perception, Saarinen has broken new ground for philosophy in the corporate world. He has been a key driver in establishing philosophy as a recognized force in the context of modern Finnish management thinking. Serving as a lecturer and a coach for Finnish companies and organizations for over a decade, Saarinen has become a leading figure in the fields of inspirational lecturing and mental coaching in Finland. Saarinen worked extensively with Nokia during the "miracle years" 1995-2006 (e.g. in Inspiring Leader program 59 times until December 2008 when the program was closed).

PHILOSOPHY OF LIFE

A key aspect of Saarinen's approach is his conviction that one should treat the human being as a whole and that each lecture or seminar should make a contribution to the life of a participant as an individual irrespective of his or her background. Saarinen's engaging and exciting lecturing style combines concrete stories, typically drawn from his own personal life, philosophical reflection without academic overtones but drawing from the rich background of both western and eastern philosophy, together with an artistic intensity in the delivery of the line of thought. Individual people as well as whole organizations report significant and sometimes astonishing changes in their actual behavior after sessions with Saarinen. Yet no straightforward advice or to-do-lists are hardly ever given by Saarinen even in his Pafos-seminar which lasts for one week and has been arranged 40 times since 1995. Saarinen does not see himself as a provider of ready answers but as a catalyst of the individual's own thought processes. This reflects Saarinen's Socratic approach to philosophy as revitalized in current context. He wants to avoid the traps of academic philosophy in its elitist and technical overtones at the same time as avoiding the traps of the mechanic and quick-fix-seeking selfhelp motivators. The intention is to generate movement of thought, fresh perspectives and personal insights in the participants in the course of an energizing lecture experience and as a result of intensified focus directed by the lecturer. Saarinen's Pafos-seminar has established itself as a groundbreaking context for accessible-to-all everyday philosophy. Since its start in 1995 and continuing biannually, the seminar has seen more than 4000 participants. Since 2004, the summer Pafos Seminar has carried the title Tulenkantajat (Torchcarriers) and has established itself as a key life philosophical coaching environment for the Finnish younger generation managers, experts and future leaders.
